Re: Proposed SEND Resource Base – Colton Hills Community School**

As you may be aware, Initial Consultation on the proposed SEND Resource Base at Colton Hills Community School concluded on 14 June 2026.

The Cabinet Member for Children, Young People and Education and the Executive Director of Families has recently reviewed the outcomes of Initial Consultation and determined that Formal Consultation (Representation) should commence for this proposal.

It is proposed that with effect from September 2027, a 20 place SEND Resource Base, for Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH), will be established at Colton Hills Community School to enable the school to support the increased demand for specialist places.

Formal Consultation:

Formal consultation on the proposed SEND Resource Base at Colton Hills Community School commenced on 14 September 2026 and runs until 11 October 2026.

In respect of this a Statutory Notice has been published in the Express & Star newspaper (please find a copy enclosed). In accordance with School Organisation Regulations, please also find enclosed a copy of the Complete Proposal.
