Re: Final Decision on Proposed Expansion Scheme - Green Park School

On 10 December 2025, the Cabinet of the City of Wolverhampton Council considered the outcome of consultation and approved the expansion of Green Park School.

The capacity of Green Park School will be permanently increased by 27 places, from 147 to 174 places, effective from September 2027.

Green Park School caters for pupils with Severe Learning Difficulty (SLD) and Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulty (PMLD).

The expansion was approved to enable the Council to continue to fulfil its statutory duty to ensure the sufficiency of school places for children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

To support the permanent expansion of the school and the increase in commissioned places to 174, additional specialist accommodation will be built on the existing school site.

While some disruption during the construction works is unavoidable, the Council will take steps to minimise the impact on pupils, parents, and school staff. Additionally, as part of the planning application process, the Council's Highways Team will assess the effect of the school's expansion and may propose measures to enhance road safety.
