**Re: Proposed Expansion Scheme - Green Park School**

As you may be aware, Initial Consultation on the proposal to expand Green Park School concluded on 6 July 2025.

The City of Wolverhampton Council's Cabinet recently reviewed the outcomes of Initial Consultation and determined that Formal Consultation (Representation) should commence for this proposal.

It is proposed that Green Park School's capacity be increased by 27 places, bringing the total to 174 places, effective from 1 September 2027. Green Park School caters for pupils with Severe Learning Difficulty (SLD) and Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulty (PMLD).

**Formal Consultation:**

Formal consultation on the proposed expansion of Green Park School commenced on 15 September 2025 and runs until 12 October 2025.

In respect of this a Statutory Notice has been published in the Express & Star newspaper (please find a copy enclosed). In accordance with School Organisation Regulations, please also find enclosed a copy of the Complete Proposal.

We welcome any responses to consultation and interested parties are invited to object to, support or comment on the proposal in one of the following ways.
