NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Orders under Sections 1, 2, 3, 84 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders is as follows:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BILSTON) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2022

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- wait at any time on any day in parts of Cleveland Road; Gordon Street; Steelhouse Lane; Sutherland Place; Vicarage Road; Un-Named Road;
- wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Cleveland Road; Gordon Street; Granville Street; Jenner Street; Steelhouse Lane; Sutherland Place; Un-Named Road; and
- wait for a period longer than 20 minutes with no return within 1 hour in part of Cleveland Road.

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders are hereby revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (SUTHERLAND PLACE AND UN-NAMED ROAD) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

This Order will prohibit any person to drive any vehicle with a maximum speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule below:

Schedule

- Un-Named Road In its entirety from its junction with Cleveland Road. 2. Sutherland Place In its entirety from its junction with Steelhouse Lane.
- THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (GORDON STREET) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING FOR ALL MOTOR **VEHICLES) ORDER 2022**

This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed along that length of road as specified in the Schedule below:

Schedule

- From a point 63 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Granville Street for a distance of 1. Gordon Street 1 metres in an eastern direction.
- THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (SUTHERLAND PLACE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING FOR ALL **MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2022**

This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed along that length of road as specified in the Schedule below:

Schedule

Sutherland Place From a point 2 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Vicarage Road for a distance of 24 metres in an eastern direction.

Under the provisions of the Highways Act 1980 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 the Wolverhampton City Council also proposes to install Traffic Calming Measures as follows:

Schedule 1

Schedule of vertical deflections

Location Type of Traffic Calming Un-named Road - commencing approximately 58 metres from the southern 75mm high raised table

kerb line of Cleveland Road for a distance of 10 metres

Sutherland Place - commencing approximately 61 metres from the western 75mm high raised table

kerb line of Steelhouse Lane for a distance of 18 metres

Sutherland Place - commencing approximately 141 metres from the western 75mm high raised table

kerb line of Steelhouse Lane for a distance of 18 metres
