NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the Order is as follows:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (PENN) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES)(AMENDMENT NO 12) ORDER 2021

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Goldthorn Hill and Wolverhampton Road East;
- (ii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload Monday to Friday between 8am to 9.30am and 4.30pm to 6.30pm in parts of Goldthorn Hill.

An existing traffic regulation order for Goldthorn Hill and Wolverhampton Road East will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.
