

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council propose to make the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WEDNESFIELD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 10) ORDER 2021

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Hobgate Road; Woden Road; Chervil Rise; Grove Street; and
- (ii) wait at any time on any day in parts of Hobgate Road; Chervil Rise.

2. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (HOBGATE ROAD & CHERVIL RISE) PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

SCHEDULE 1

Schedule of vertical deflections

Location

Type of Traffic Calming

Hobgate Road - Flat top road hump 21 metres from the eastern kerb line of Woden Road	75mm high
Hobgate Road - Flat top road hump 92 metres from the eastern kerb line of Woden Road	75mm high
Hobgate Road - Flat top road hump 36 metres from the eastern kerb line of Hobgate Close	75mm high
Hobgate Road - Flat top road hump 62 metres from the eastern end of Hobgate Road	75mm high
Chervil Rise - Flat top road hump 67 metres from the western kerb line of Grove Street	75mm high
