

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 26 October 2021 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 29 October 2021 is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BARNHURST LANE) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

No person shall drive any vehicle with a maximum speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

1. Barnhurst Lane From a point 100m south of its junction with The Droveaway, to 20m north of its junction with Ryefield.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 26 October 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
