

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 25 August 2020 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 27 August 2020 are as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (KEEPERS LANE, WOLVERHAMPTON) (7.5 TONNES ENVIRONMENTAL WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2019

This Order will prohibit (save for the specific exceptions referred to in the Order) any vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the length of the roads specified in Schedule 1 below.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Keepers Lane From its junction with Wergs Road to the Wolverhampton City Council administrative boundary.
2. Wergs Drive In its entirety from its junction with Keepers Lane.
3. Chatsworth Gardens In its entirety from its junction with Keepers Lane.

2. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WEDNESFIELD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 5) ORDER 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Cambridge Street; Water Street; Hilton Street;
- (ii) stop at any time on any day on school entrance markings in parts of Cambridge Street; Water Street;
- (iii) wait for a period longer than 20 minutes with no return within 2 hours Monday to Friday 8am to 5.30pm in parts of Cambridge Street;

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 25 August 2020 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
