2. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BRADLEY LANE & CROSS STREET) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) **ORDER 2020**

No person shall drive any vehicle with a maximum speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule

- Bradley Lane From a point 240m south west of its junction with Great Bridge Street, being the 1. administrative boundary, to its junction with Cross Street.
- From its junction with Bradley Lane to its junction with Rose Street/Wilkinson Avenue. 2. Cross Street
