

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 17 October 2023 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2, and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which come into operation on 19 October 2021 are as follows:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL
(VICTORIA SQUARE 24HR BUS GATE) ORDER 2023

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the Bus Gate.

SCHEDULE 1

That area of carriageway, the length of which extends between its junctions with Berry Street, Pipers Row and Fryer Street, Lichfield Street and Railway Drive which is bounded by the kerb line on its western and eastern sides and as detailed on the plan supplement.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 17 October 2023 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
