THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WOLVERHAMPTON CITY CENTRE – METRO EXTENSION) (BUS LANES, MANDATORY TURNS AND PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2022

Wolverhampton City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:

1. Citation and commencement

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation on the 30day of December 2022 and may be cited as The Wolverhampton City Council (City Centre Metro Extension) (Bus Lanes, Mandatory Turns and Prohibition of Driving) Order 2022.
- 1.2 The Wolverhampton City Council (City Centre Metro Extension)(Bus Lanes, Mandatory Turns and Prohibition of Driving) Order 2022.

2. Interpretation

In this Order the following words and phrases (where used) have the meanings ascribed to them as follows:-

"Bus" means a public passenger vehicle as defined in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Bus Lane" means the area of carriageway specified in the Schedule;

"Bus Only Road" means any road specified in Table 3 and has the same effect as if it were a Bus Lane in accordance with the Transport Act 2000;

"Cycle" means a cycle as defined in section 192(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"Motor Vehicle" as defined in section 136 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

"Ring & Ride" means a demand responsive transport service authorised by Wolverhampton City Council;

"Hackney Carriage" means a licensed hackney carriage;

"Private Hire Vehicle" means a licensed private hire vehicle;

"Emergency Service Vehicle" means those vehicles being used for fire, police or ambulance purposes;

"Tramcar Only Road" means any road specified in Table 3 and has the same effect as if it were a Bus Lane in accordance with the Transport Act 2000;

"Tramcar" means any railway or part of a railway, authorised by the Midland Metro Acts 1989 to 1993 and thereby designated as a tramway.

One Way Traffic

- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall, except with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 2 of Table 1 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 3 of that Table.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Cycle to proceed along Railway Drive in a westerly direction for access.

Mandatory turns

- 5. Save as provided in Article 6 no person shall, except with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the roads specified: -
 - (a) In column 2 of Table 2 other than for making the manoeuvre specified in column 3 of that Table.
- 6. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall apply in respect of a pedal-Cycle insofar as it relates to item 2.1 of Table 1.

Prohibition of movement

- 7. Save as provided in Article 8 no person shall, except with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the roads specified: -
 - (a) In column 2 of Table 4 other than for making the manoeuvre specified in column 3 of that Table.
- 8. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall apply in respect of a pedal-Cycle insofar as it relates to item 4.1 of Table 4.

Railway Drive Prohibition of Driving

- 9. Save as provided in Article 10 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road specified in Item 3.5 in Table 3 to this Order. Unless it is a vehicle travelling in a westerly direction for egress only.
- 10. Article 9 shall not apply to Tramcar or pedal Cycle.

Pipers Row Prohibition of Driving

- 11. Save as provided in Article 12 no person shall, except with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in items 3.1 3.4 of column 2 of Table 3 in the direction shown column 3 of that table at any time: Unless a valid exemption exists.
- 12. Article 11 shall not apply to a-pedal Cycle
- 13. Nothing in Articles 3, 5, 7 and 9 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed on the roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable-
 - (a) the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said roads;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in section 151 of the Communications Act 2003; and
 - (v) the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local

authority or its contractors in pursuance of that authority's statutory powers or duties;

- (vi) motor vehicles undertaking the transport of bullion / security delivery and collections to premises within the pedestrian zone;
- (b) motor vehicles in the service of the Royal Mail company (as defined in section 2(6) of the Postal Services Act 2011), to be used for the purpose of delivering and/or collecting mail.

Revocations

14. Existing traffic regulation Orders to Fryer Street, Lichfield Street, Pipers Row and Railway Drive are hereby revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.
