

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 24 February 2026 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2, and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which come into operation on 27 February 2026 is as follows:

**THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BILSTON)
(OXFORD STREET) (MANDATORY LEFT TURNS)
ORDER 2026**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to proceed:

- (i) in the direction in the roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1
- (ii) in a direction other than making a left turn from the road specified in column 2
- (iii) into the road specified in column 3 of Schedule 1

SCHEDULE 1

1	Hare Street	Oxford Street
2	Chapel Street	Oxford Street

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 24 February 2026 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
