

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 18 August 2020 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2, and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 20 August 2020 are as follows:

**1. The Wolverhampton City Council (Wednesfield) (Prohibition of Stopping) (Amendment No 15) Order 2019**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to stop between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday on school entrance markings in parts of Old Fallings Lane.

Existing traffic regulation orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

**2. The Wolverhampton City Council (City Centre) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places)(Electric Vehicles) (Amendment No 2) Order 2019**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time on any day in an Electric Vehicle Charging Point bay (as defined in the Order) in parts of Birch Street, Market Street, Park Road West, Princess Street and Red Hill Street, other than an Electric Vehicle (as defined in the Order), or Plug in Hybrid Vehicle (as defined in the Order), which are being used for charging purposes as permitted under the Order.

An Electric Vehicle or Plug in Hybrid Vehicle is permitted to wait for a maximum period of 1.5 hours in the Electric Vehicle Charging Point bay for charging purposes only, with no return within 2 hours of use for charging purposes of the Electric Vehicle or Plug in Hybrid Vehicle.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 18 August 2020 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
