

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 16 July 2024 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2, 84 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 19 July 2024 is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (OLD HALL STREET) (MANDATORY TURNS) ORDER 2024

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to proceed in the road specified in column 2 of the Schedule in this Order in a direction other than a right turn into that road specified in column 3 of that schedule.

SCHEDULE

(1) Item	(2) From Road	(3) To Road
1.	Old Hall Street	St George's Parade

2. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (OLD HALL STREET) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 3 of that schedule.

SCHEDULE

(1) Item	(2) From Road	(3) To Road
1.	Old Hall Street - between its junctions with Garrick Street and St George's Parade.	Towards George's St Parade

3. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (ST GEORGE'S PARADE) (PROHIBITED TURN) ORDER 2024

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads specified in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order to make a right turn into the road specified in relation to that road in Column 3 of the schedule.

SCHEDULE

(1) Item	(2) From Road	(3) To Road
1.	St George's Parade.	Old Hall Street

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 16 July 2024 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
