THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (CYCLE LANES) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 17 October 2023 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2,124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into effect on 19 October 2023 is as follows:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (CYCLE LANES) **ORDER 2023**

This Order will change the designation of the existing highway detailed in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Order and detailed on the Plan Supplement to that of a dedicated Cycle Lane facility.

Schedule 1

Queen Square Lichfield Street

Creation of a contraflow cycle lane allowing cyclists to cycle on the northern side of Queen Square and Lichfield Street for the areas shown on the Plan Supplement

Schedule 2

Darlington Street

Creation of a contraflow cycle lane allowing cyclists to cycle on the northern side of Darlington Street for the areas shown on the Plan Supplement

2. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (ONE WAY STREETS) **ORDER 2023**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2

SCHEDULE 1

Darlington Street (Southwest bound) -

Towards Red Lion Street between its iunction with North Street and Red Lion

- Street Queen Square (Southwest bound) -Towards North Street between its junction with Lichfield Street and North Street
- Lichfield Street (Southwest bound) -Towards Queen Square between its junction with Princess Street and Queen Square

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (PROHIBITION AND 3. **RESTRICTION OF LOADING) ORDER 2023** This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time in a designated Loading Bay

at any time of day, unless it is to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Lichfield Street as specified on the Plan Supplement.

Existing traffic regulation orders to Lichfield Street are hereby revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.
