

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 6 April 2021 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1) (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 9 April 2021 are as follows:

1. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 3) Order 2021

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of Prouds Lane; Abbey Road; Carnaby Street; Harper Road.

2. The Wolverhampton City Council (Prouds Lane) (Mandatory Turn) Order 2021

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to proceed from the Private Drive of 33 to 37 Prouds Lane to proceed along Prouds Lane south bound in a direction other than a left turn.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 6 April 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
