This order is made by Wolverhampton City Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to stop up the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely development of four semi-detached bungalows on the former garage site located behind 23 to 33 Beach Avenue, Spring Vale, Wolverhampton West Midlands in accordance with outline and reserved matters planning permission numbers 17/00005/OUT and 19/01481/REM.

#### BY THIS ORDER:

- The footpath over the land shown edged with a red dashed line on the attached map and described in Part I of the Schedule to this order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up as provided below.
- 2. The stopping up of the footpath shall have effect on the confirmation of this order.
- 3. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is stopped up there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
