PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 22 December 2021 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under sections 1, 1(1), 2, 2(1), 2(2) and 124 (1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the Orders which will come into operation on 24 December 2021 is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - WESTSIDE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 2) ORDER 2021

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to

- Wait at any time on any day in parts of Cleveland Passage, Victoria Passage, Skinner Street and Fold Street.
- Wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Bell Street, Skinner Street, Cleveland Street, Summer Row, Salop Street and Worcester Street.

Wait at any time on any day and to load and unload Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 9.30am and 5.00pm to 6.30pm in parts of School Street.

- Wait between 8.30am and 6.00pm for a period longer than 30 minutes (with no return within 2 hours) for the purpose of plying for hire in part of Salop Street.
- Wait in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand in parts of Bell Street and Salop Street.
- (vi) Wait in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand between 6.00pm and 6.00am nor to load or unload between 6.00am to 6.00pm on any day in parts of Skinner Street, Salop Street, School Street, Cleveland Street and Worcester Street
- (vii) Wait in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand between 6.00pm and 8.30am in parts of School Street and Salop Street as specified on the Plans to the Order.
- (viii)Wait in any disabled person's parking place in parts of Salop Street.
- (ix) Wait in a disabled person's parking place unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for a period longer than 3 hours with no return within 1 hour in parts of Bell Street and Salop Street.
- Load and unload at any time on any day in part of Victoria Passage
- (xi) Stop in any designated bus stop or bus stand.

Existing traffic regulation orders to Bell Street, Cleveland Street, Cleveland Passage, Skinner Street, School Street, Salop Street, Fold Street, Worcester Street, Summer Row, Pit Street and Victoria Passage will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - WESTSIDE LINK PHASE 1) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING MANDATORY TURNS AND ONE-WAY STREETS) ORDER 2021

Bell Street prohibition of driving - This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed along that length of road specified in Schedule 1. This shall not apply to pedal cycles.

Victoria Street prohibition of driving - This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 in the direction in column 2 of Schedule 2 between the hours of 8.30am - 5pm and 10pm - 6am. This shall not apply to pedal cycles.

Mandatory turns - This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed in the roads specified: -

- (a) In column 2 of Schedule 3 in a direction other than making a left turn from the road specified in column 2 into the road specified in column 3 of Schedule 3.
- In column 2 of Schedule 4 in a direction other than making a right turn from the road specified in column 2 into the road specified in column 3 of Schedule 4.
- In column 2 of Schedule 5 in a direction other than to go straight ahead from the road specified in column 2 into the road specified in column 3 of Schedule 5.

The above shall not apply in respect of pedal cycles insofar as it relates to item 1 of Schedule 4 and item 1 of Schedule 5.

One Way Street - This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 6 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2 of that Schedule. REVOCATIONS

Column 1 - Road

Existing traffic regulation orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order and Schedules to the Order.

Existing traffic regulation orders to Bell Street, Cleveland Street, Cleveland Passage, Skinner Street, School Street, Salop Street, Fold Street, Worcester Street, Summer Row, Pit Street and Victoria Passage will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order (to include the Schedules).

The Borough of Wolverhampton (Bell Street) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) Order 1991 relating to Bell Street one-way traffic will be revoked in its entirety to re-introduce two-way traffic on this road. The Wolverhampton County Borough Council (Various Roads) (One-Way Street) No. 76 Order 1970 relating to Bell Street one-way traffic will be revoked in its entirety to re-introduce two-way traffic on this road. The Wolverhampton County Borough Council (Traffic Regulation) No. 42 Order 1967 relating to Skinner Street one-way traffic will be revoked in its entirety to re-introduce two-way traffic on this road.

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - WESTSIDE) (PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE) (WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2021

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time or load or un-load between the hours of 10pm and 6am and 8.30am and 5pm on any road identified in the Schedule.

Existing traffic regulation orders will be varied or revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Bell Street From its junction with Victoria Street to a point 10 metres west of the projected western kerb line of Cleveland Passage.

Victoria Street From its junction with Queen Square/Darlington Street to its junction with Salop Street/Cleveland Street.

Skinner Street From its junction with Victoria Street to a point 5 metres east of the projected western kerb line of Victoria Passage.

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - WESTSIDE) (EVENTS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021 Prohibition of access - This order will prohibit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any length of the road specified in Schedule 1 unless the vehicle is being used for fire, police or ambulance purposes or is being used

in pursuance of statutory powers or duties. Prohibition of stopping - This order will prohibit any vehicle to stop or remain at rest in any length of the road specified in Schedule 2.

Exempted vehicles - Nothing in the Order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the enforcement of prohibited traffic movements in the roads specified in Schedules 1 and 2 of this Order.

Suspensions - Existing traffic regulation orders will be suspended for the length of time duly stated prior to and post the Event to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Revocations - Existing traffic regulation orders will be varied or revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

5. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - WESTSIDE LINK PHASE 1) (CYCLE LANES, CYCLE WAYS AND SHARED USE FOOTWAYS) ORDER 2021

This Order shall prohibit any vehicle loading or unloading on Victoria Street (within the pedestrian and Cycle zone) between the hours of 6am to 8.30am and 5pm to 10pm within Victoria Street. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 22 December 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
