

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 6 June 2023 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 9 June 2023 is as follows:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - TAXI RANKS) (PROHIBITIONS OF WAITING AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) stop at any time on any day in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage other than for the purpose of plying for hire in parts of Castle Street, Lichfield Street, Snow Hill, Tower Street; and
- (ii) wait at any time on any day in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage other than for the purpose of plying for hire in parts of Bailey Street, Bell Street, Chubb Street, Darlington Street, Market Street; and
- (iii) wait at any time on any day in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage between 6.00pm and 6.00am on any day other than for the purpose of plying for hire in parts of Darlington Street; and
- (iv) wait in any loading area between 6.00am to 6.00pm on any day except for loading or unloading of goods in connection with adjoining trade or business in part of Darlington Street; and
- (v) wait in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage between 11.00pm and 6.00am on any day other than for the purpose of plying for hire in parts of Princess Street, Wulfruna Street; and
- (vi) wait in any loading area between 6.00am to 11.00pm on any day except for loading or unloading of goods in connection with adjoining trade or business in parts of Princess Street, Wulfruna Street; and
- (vii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Princess Street; and
- (viii) wait in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage between 6:00pm and 3:00am on any day other than for the purpose of plying for hire and to load or unload by authorised security vehicles only between 3.00am to 6.00pm on any day in parts of Queen Square; and
- (ix) wait in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage between 6.30pm and 6.00am on any day other than for the purpose of plying for hire and to load or unload between 8.30am to 9.30am and 5.00pm to 6.00am on any day in parts of Lichfield Street; and
- (x) wait in any loading area between 6.00am to 8.30am and 9.30am to 5.00pm on any day except for loading or unloading of goods in connection with adjoining trade or business in parts of Lichfield Street; and
- (xi) wait at any time in any day in any duly authorised hackney carriage stand except a licensed hackney carriage between 6:00pm and 8:30am on any day other than for the purpose of plying for hire in parts of Market Street; and
- (xii) wait in a disabled person's parking place unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for no longer period than 3 hours with no return within 1 hour between 8:30am to 6:00pm on any day in parts of Market Street; as specified on the Plans and provided that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the valid disabled person's badge has been issued or as the case may be, used for the carrying of disabled person(s) as passengers(s).

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 6 June 2023 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
