

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 16 February 2021 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 124(1) (d) and Part III of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 19 February 2021 are as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WEDNESFIELD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 21) ORDER 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Wolverhampton Road; New Cross Avenue; Graiseley Lane;
- (ii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload between 7.30am to 9.30am and 4.30pm to 6.30pm in parts of Wolverhampton Road.

2. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (TETTENHALL) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day in parts of St Andrews Close;
- (ii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of St Andrews Close; Craddock Street; Hordern Road; Hunter Street;
- (iii) wait in a disabled person's parking place unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for a longer period than 3 hours with no return within 1 hour in part of St Andrews Close as specified on the Plans. Provided that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the badge has been issued or as the cause may be, used for the carrying of disabled person(s) as passengers(s).

3. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (TETTENHALL) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 18) ORDER 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Stafford Road.

4. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (STAFFORD ROAD) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

This Order will cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along Stafford Road from its junction with M54 Junction 2 for a distance of 30 metres in a western direction.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 16 February 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
