

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 3 May 2022 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 6 May 2022 are as follows:

**THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL**  
**(BILSTON) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION**  
**OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES)**  
**(AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2022**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Hill Avenue, Gordon Avenue, Cranford Avenue, Pruden Avenue, Pritchett Avenue, Ward Grove, Lapper Avenue and Waverley Crescent; and
- (ii) wait between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and to load and unload between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Gordon Avenue.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 3 May 2022 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
