

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 14 February 2023 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 17 February 2023 is as follows:

**1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WEDNESFIELD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 2) ORDER 2022**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait between 7am to 7pm on any day and to load and unload between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Woden Road; and
- (ii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Woden Road and Charles Drive.

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 14 February 2023 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
