

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 7 May 2024 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2, 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 10 May 2024 is as follows:

**1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (PENN) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 9) ORDER 2023**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) stop at any time on any day on school entrance markings in parts of Bhylls Lane;
- (ii) wait between 8.00am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and to load and unload between 8.00am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Bhylls Lane;
- (iii) wait at any time on any day in parts of Bhylls Lane; and
- (iv) wait in a disabled person's parking place unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for no longer period than 30 minutes with no return within 1 hour between 8.00am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Bhylls Lane; Provided that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the valid disabled person's badge has been issued or as the case may be, used for the carrying of disabled person(s) as passengers(s).

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 7 May 2024 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
