

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 2 March 2021 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under sections 1, 2 and 124 (1) (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 5 March 2021 is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BILSTON) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 20) ORDER 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day in parts of Cleveland Road;
- (ii) wait for a period longer than 4 hours with no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday between 8am to 6.30pm in parts of Cleveland Road.

An existing traffic regulation order to Cleveland Road will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 2 March 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
