

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 3 November 2020 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 6 November 2020 are as follows:

1. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 1) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of Dartmouth Street.

2. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 2) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of Hurst Road.

3. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 3) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit (save for the specific exceptions referred to in the Order) any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Thornton Road, Cavendish Road and Stow Heath Lane;
- (ii) wait between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and to load and unload between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Thornton Road.

4. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 5) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of Wesley Street.

5. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 6) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of Bradley Lane and Stirling Road.

6. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 7) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Moreton Avenue, Hateley Drive and Kenilworth Crescent;
- (ii) wait between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and to load and unload between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Moreton Avenue and Kenilworth Crescent.

7. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 8) Order 2020

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Wallace Road, School Drive and Pace Crescent;
- (ii) wait between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and to load and unload between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Wallace Road.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 3 November 2020 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
