

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on 1 September 2020 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which come into operation on 3 September 2020 are as follows:

**1. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BILSTON) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 14) ORDER 2019**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait in a disabled person's parking place unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for a longer period than 3 hours on any day in part of Mountford Lane;
- (ii) stop between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday on school entrance markings in part of Mountford Lane;
- (iii) wait for a period longer than 1 hour between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday in part of Mountford Lane;

**2. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (TETTENHALL) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 8) ORDER 2019**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of The Droveaway; as specified on the Plan.

**3. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (TETTENHALL) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 6) ORDER 2019**

This Order will prohibit:

- (i) any vehicle to stop at any time on school entrance markings in parts of Rakegate Close;
- (ii) any vehicle to wait for a period longer than 30 minutes with no return within 2 hours between 8am to 9.30am and 2pm to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday in parts of Rakegate Close;

**4. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (TETTENHALL) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 7) ORDER 2019**

This Order will prohibit:

- (i) any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in parts of School Road, Tanfield Close, Woodland Avenue and Long Lake Avenue;
- (ii) any vehicle to wait between 8am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday in parts of School Road;

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 1 September 2020 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
