## THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BILSTON) (GREEN PARK AVENUE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

The Wolverhampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the act, hereby make the following Order: -

- This Order shall come into operation on the day of and may be cited as The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Green Park Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023.
- 2. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Green Park Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023 includes a plan ("the Plan") incorporated in The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Green Park Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023 Plan Supplement ("the Plan Supplement").
- 3. No person shall, except on the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
