

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL
(BILSTON) (GREEN PARK AVENUE) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC)

ORDER 2023

The Wolverhampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on the day of
and may be cited as The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Green Park Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023.

2. The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Green Park Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023 includes a plan (“the Plan”) incorporated in The Wolverhampton City Council (Bilston) (Green Park Avenue) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023 Plan Supplement (“the Plan Supplement”).

3. No person shall, except on the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in Column 2 of that Schedule.

Column 1	Column 2
Green Park Avenue – from its junction with Wolseley Road.	In a north-easterly direction to approximately 12 metres before its junction with Lime Grove.
