Dear Occupier,

Consultation – Christ Church Junior School – Safer Routes to School

Wolverhampton City Council is consulting with local residents and businesses on proposed road safety improvements in the vicinity of Christ Church Junior School, identified as a priority location under the Safer Routes to School (SRTS) programme.

Proposed Measures.

- Creation of a designated Safe School Zone, including school zone signs, and road markings, and the introduction of a 20mph speed limit on the roads as indicated on the attached plan to enhance safety for students and pedestrians.
- Introduction of waiting and loading restrictions at the junctions of Woodcote Road and Dovecote Close and School Keep Clear markings near 49-53 Woodcote Road.

Please refer to the attached plans for full details of the proposed scheme.

The SRTS programme is designed to improve road safety for students and local residents, reduce traffic congestion and on-street parking issues near schools and encourage walking and rolling to school, promoting healthier lifestyles and better air quality.


Scheme consultation closes on **29 August 2025**.
