NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Orders under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BARNHURST LANE) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

No person shall drive any vehicle with a maximum speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule.

Schedule of vertical deflections

Location

Barnhurst Lane - between its junctions with Ryefield to 100m south of its junction with The Droveaway

Barnhurst Lane - between Aldersley High School egress and entrance to the Barnhurst Lane pitches

Barnhurst Lane - at the existing toucan crossing directly in front of Aldersley High School entrance

Type of Traffic Calming

5 sets of **speed cushions** 75mm high speed cushion

1 set of **Flat Top Hump** 75mm high speed cushion

1 set of **Raised Crossing** 75mm high Junction Table
