

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (KEEPERS LANE, WOLVERHAMPTON)
(7.5 TONNES ENVIRONMENTAL WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2019

Wolverhampton City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on
and may be cited as The Wolverhampton City Council (Keepers Lane, Wolverhampton) (7.5 Tonnes Environmental Weight Restriction) Order 2019.
2. Save as provided in Article 3, 4 and 5, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the length of the road specified in the Schedule 1 to this order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle over 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of the road specified therein, if the vehicle is being used in connection with fire, police or ambulance purposes.
4. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle over 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of the road specified therein, to allow the vehicle to load or unload from any adjacent premises.
5. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle over 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of the road specified therein, to access off street parking facilities.
