

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and section 3 of the Cycle Track Act 1984 and pursuant to the Cycle Track Regulations 1984. The effect of the Orders is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (CYCLE LANES) ORDER 2023

This Order will prohibit any vehicle at any time other than a Cycle to enter or proceed in the Cycle Lanes as specified in the below Schedule 1 and 2:

SCHEDULE 1

Darlington Street Queen Square Lichfield Street	Creation of a contraflow cycle lane allowing cyclists to cycle on the northern side of Darlington Street, Queen Square and Lichfield Street for the areas shown on the Plan Supplement

SCHEDULE 2

Darlington Street	Creation of a with flow cycle lane allowing cyclists to cycle on the northern side of Darlington Street for the areas shown on the Plan Supplement

2. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (ONE WAY STREETS) ORDER 2023

This Order will prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2 of that Schedule as below:

SCHEDULE 1

<u>Length of Road</u>	<u>Direction</u>
Darlington Street (Southwest bound) between its junction with North Street and Red Lion Street	Towards Red Lion Street
Queen Square (Southwest bound) between its junction with Lichfield Street and North Street	Towards North Street
Lichfield Street (Southwest bound) between its junction with Princess Street and Queen Square	Towards Queen Square

3. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF LOADING) ORDER 2023

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait in a designated Loading Bay at any time of day unless it is to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Lichfield Street.

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.
