NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers. The effect of the Order is as follows:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CITY CENTRE - METRO EXTENSION) (CYCLE TRACKS AND SHARED USE FOOTWAYS) ORDER 2023

This Order will prohibit any vehicle other than a Cycle at any time to enter or proceed in the Cycle Lanes specified in Schedule 1 below nor the footways specified in Schedule 2 below;

Railway Drive	Creation of a two-way segregated cycle lane allowing cyclists to cycle on the southern side of Railway Drive for the areas shown on the Plan Supplement

Schedule 2

Bilston Street Fryer Street Lichfield Street Queen's Square Pipers Row Railway Drive St Georges Parade	Conversion of the footway to a shared footway/cycleway allowing cyclists to cycle on the southern footway of Railway Drive and parts of the footways for the areas shown on the Plan Supplement
