#### **Type of Traffic Calming**

Cleveland Road - Raised table starting 10 metres from the eastern kerb line of Hospital Street to the end of Cleveland Road at its junction with Steelhouse Lane.

75mm high raised table

Neville Patten Gardens - Raised table starting 9 metres from the Southern kerb line of Cleveland Road to its junction with Cleveland Road.

75mm high raised table
