SCHEDULE 1 SCHEDULE OF VERTICAL DEFLECTIONS

Location	Type of Traffic Calming
Newhampton Road East - 10 sets of speed cushions between its junctions with Waterloo Road and Walpole Street.	75mm high speed cushion
Newhampton Road East - 2 sets of flat top raised pedestrian crossings between its junctions with Waterloo Road and Walpole Street.	75mm high hump
Newhampton Road West - 15 sets of speed cushions between its junctions with A41 Tettenhall Road and Walpole Street.	75mm high speed cushion
Newhampton Road West - 2 sets of flat top raised pedestrian crossings between its junctions with A41 Tettenhall Road and Walpole Street.	75mm high hump
