NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council propose to implement local safety measures consisting of:

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (CAMBRIDGE STREET, WATER STREET) PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

The Council proposes to introduce enhanced traffic calming measures under the provisions of the Highways Act 1980 section 90C as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 and all other enabling powers, as follows:

SCHEDULE 1

SCHEDULE OF VERTICAL DEFLECTIONS

Location

Type of Traffic Calming

Cambridge Street - 5 flat top humps

75mm high flat top hump

Approximately 12 metres from the junction with Cannock Road to approximately 21 metres from the northern kerb line of its junction with Water Street.

Water Street - 2 flat top humps

75mm high flat top hump

Approximately 21 metres from the eastern kerb line of its junction with Cambridge Street to approximately 13 metres from its junction with Hilton Street.
