The Council proposes to introduce traffic calming measures under the provisions of the Highways Act 1980 section 90C as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 and all other enabling powers as follows:

SCHEDULE 1

Schedule of vertical deflections

Location

Dixon Street – 14 sets of speed cushions
Between its junctions with Thompson Avenue to 100m north-east of its junction with D'Urberville Road.

Type of Traffic Calming

75mm high speed cushion
