- wait for a period longer than 3 hours with no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6.30pm in parts of Nichols Fold and Woodhouse Fold as specified on the Plan: (iv) wait in a disabled person's parking place unless:
 - (a) there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for a period longer than 3 hours with no return
 - within 1 hour in parts of High Street and Nicholls Fold as specified on the Plan; and
 - (b) provided also that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking in the disabled person's parking place has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the valid disabled person's badge has been issued or as the case may be, used for the carrying of disabled person(s) as passengers(s); wait Monday to Saturday between 2pm to 10.00am unless such waiting is necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle
- in connection with adjoining trade or business premises in parts of High Street and Church Street as specified on the Plan;
- (vi) wait at any time on any day or to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Woodhouse Fold, Nicholls Fold, Alfred Squire Road. High Street, Church Street and Graiseley Lane as specified on the Plan.
