

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1) (d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WOLVERHAMPTON CITY CENTRE METRO EXTENSION) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING LOADING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2022

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Bilston Street, Fryer Street, Lichfield Street and St Georges Parade.

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.
