

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Wolverhampton City Council propose to make the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1) (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is as follows:

## **The Wolverhampton City Council (Tettenhall) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No 1) Order 2020**

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait at any time on any day in parts of St Andrews Close;
- (ii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of St Andrews Close; Craddock Street; Hordern Road; Hunter Street;
- (iii) wait in a disabled person's parking place unless there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge for a longer period than 3 hours with no return within 1 hour in part of St Andrews Close as specified on the Plans. Provided that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the badge has been issued or as the cause may be, used for the carrying of disabled person(s) as passengers(s).
