

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Orders is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WEDNESFIELD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 2) ORDER 2022

This Order will prohibit any vehicle to:

- (i) wait between 7am to 7pm on any day and to load and unload between 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm Monday to Friday in parts of Woden Road; and
- (ii) wait at any time on any day and to load and unload at any time on any day in parts of Woden Road and Charles Drive.

Existing Traffic Regulation Orders will be revoked to the extent necessary to facilitate the provisions of this Order.

2. WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (WODEN ROAD) PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

The Council proposes to introduce traffic calming measures under the provisions of the Highways Act 1980 Section 90(c) as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 and all other enabling powers as follows:

SCHEDULE 1

Schedule of vertical deflections

Location	Type of Traffic Calming
Woden Road - 4 number of speed cushions between its junctions with Charles Drive to its junction with Hobgate Road	75mm high speed cushion
Woden Road - 1 set of Flat Top Hump (kerb to kerb) between St Stephen's CofE Primary School pedestrian egress and entrance and Charles Drive	75mm high hump
