PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF CONTROLLED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING (ZEBRA) PROUD'S LANE, BILSTON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install a controlled (Zebra) crossing on Proud's Lane, Bilston.

The crossing will help to increase pedestrian safety by the provision of a controlled crossing place for pedestrians to cross Proud's Lane in the vicinity of Villiers Primary School.
