

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (SHAW ROAD) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1 (1), 2(1) to (3), 9, 10(1) and (2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of the Order is as follows :

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the road specified in column 1 of the Schedule below to proceed in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2 of the Schedule below (as shown on the Plan attached to the Experimental Order)

Schedule: Roads subject to Prohibited Movement

Column 1

Shaw Road - from its junction with
Bushbury Lane.

Column 2

In a southerly direction to its junction
with Showell Road.

The Order will come into operation on 26 July 2020 for a maximum period of 18 months or until the Order is made permanent.

Wolverhampton City Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely.

Within a period of 6 months beginning on the date on which the Experimental Order comes into force, or if that order is varied by another order or modified pursuant to Section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning on the date which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation. Any such objections must be in writing to the undersigned and stating the ground for the objection.
