

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 16 February 2021 Wolverhampton City Council made the following Order under Sections 84 and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 19 February 2021 is as follows:

1. THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (STAFFORD ROAD) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

This Order will prohibit any person from driving any vehicle with a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule below:

(Northbound carriageway) | From a point 110 metres north of the northern kerbline of Farmbrook Avenue in a northerly direction for a distance of 91 metres. |
| (ii) Stafford Road
(Southbound carriageway) | From a point 110 metres north of the northern kerbline of Farmbrook Avenue in a northerly direction for a distance of 121 metres. |

The County Council of West Midlands (A449 Stafford Road, Wolverhampton)(40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1985 will be varied, so that the provisions of the 1985 Order no longer apply and are revoked as regards the lengths of roads specified in the above Schedule only. The 1985 Order will remain in full force and effect and without variation or revocation in respect of all other lengths of road and matters contained and referred to within the same.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order(s), on the ground(s) that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground(s) that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulation under the said Part III has not been complied with may, within six weeks of 16 February 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
